Itinerary

Day.1

Arrive Bhubaneswar

Arrive at Bhubaneswar Airport and en route, visit Pipli, Hirapur, Dhauli and Lingaraja Temple. Then, drive to Konark for a visit to Sun Temple Pagoda at Konark (The Sun Temple), Chandrabhaga Beach and Ramachandi Temple. Later, proceed for half-day sightseeing. Facilities for overnight stay will be arranged in Puri.

Bhubaneswar

After breakfast, visit Sri Jagannath Temple and Gundicha Temple. Visit the top tourist attractions in Satpada and in Chilika, spot Irrawaddy dolphins. After a full-day sightseeing tour of Satpada,

return to Puri where facilities for overnight stay will be arranged.

Day.3

Bhubaneswar - Dhauli - Pipli - Konarak - Puri (70 kms / 3-4 hrs)

In the morning, enjoy a delicious breakfast and later, check out from the hotel. Drive to Bhubaneswar and proceed for half-day sightseeing of tribal museum, Udayagiri and Khandagiri Caves. In the evening, stroll around Bhubaneswar Market. Enjoy your overnight stay in Bhubaneswar.

Puri

Relish a tasty breakfast and check out from the hotel. Drive to Nandankanan Zoo and enjoy the safari and a nice lunch at Nandankanan. Later, transfer to Bhubaneswar Airport and enjoy your journey ahead.

Puri - Chilka Lake - Puri

This morning you will proceed on a full day excursion to visit the famous Chilka lake- the largest brackish water lake in the Asia spreading over 1100 sq kms and famous for its migratory birds and irawadi dolphins. It attracts a large number of migratory birds, like the flamingo, teal, bar headed goose, shoveller and white - bellied sea eagle. For bird-lovers, Chilika is best visited in winter when the migratory populations wing in from places as far as Siberia. Evening is at leisure for shopping and individual activities, overnight at the hotel.

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Sightseeing

Bhubaneswar

Bhubaneswar is home to some of the finest temples including the Lingaraja Temple and Mukteswar Temple. Nearby places of interest include the sacred pilgrimage town of Puri and the quiet ocean-side village of Gopalpur-on-Sea. Other tourist attractions include the State Museum, Bindu Sarovara and Nandan Kanan.



Dhuli

Dhuli hills are located on the banks of the river Daya, 8 km south of Bhubaneswar in Odisha (India). It is a hill with vast open space adjoining it, and has major Edicts of Ashoka engraved on a mass of rock, by the side of the road leading to the summit of the hill.



Pipili

Pipili (also known as Pipli) is a town and a NAC under jurisdiction of Puri district in the Indian state of Odisha. It is famous for designing beautiful Applique handicrafts. It is a town of artisans famous for their colourful fabrics.



Konark

Konark is a medium town in the Puri district in the state of Odisha, India. It lies on the coast by the Bay of Bengal, 65 kilometers from the capital of the state, Bhubaneswar. It is the site of the 13th-century Sun Temple, also known as the Black Pagoda, built in black granite during the reign of Narasimhadeva-I.

Puri is the spiritual capital of Odisha, known as a pious city filled with noted temples, shrines, Maths, Ashrams, natural wonders, beaches, architectural splendor and many more things those attracts world over tourists.



Chilika Lake
